Italian Reds

Pala, "Silenzi" Carignano, Sardegna 32. Fuller-bodied, red fruit, spice, and earth on the nose, rich black raspberry & black currants with touches of earth, smooth tannins, dry finish

Basilisco, "Teodosio"
Aglianico del Vulture, Basilicata 32.
Broad bouquet infused with dark spice, dried blackberry and a hint of milk chocolate, long & dusty finish

Bruno Giacosa Dolcetto, Piemonte 34.

Black cherry, blackberry, graphite and subtle dark chocolate flavors. Solid dusty tannins.

Colosi, Nero d'Avola, Sicilia 36. Medium-bodied, juicy wild strawberry w/ bright, citrusy acidity and light tannins

Altesino, Rosso di Toscana 40. Black cherry and light spice flavors, with earthy elements, Sangiovese, Merlot & Cab

Zaccagnini Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 40.

Ripe cherry and tobacco aromas, medium-full body, concentrated fruit with balanced acidity and a long finish

Leone de Castris
Primitivo, Puglia 40.
Plumped cherry, spice, touch of citrus peel, hints of smoke & loamy earth, round and balanced, med-bodied

Allegrini "Palazzo della Torre" Valpolicella, Veneto 44. Black cherry, mocha & nutmeg; polished tannins & acidity

Vietti Barbera D'Asti, Piemonte 44.

Dry, medium bodied wine with notes of spice, berries and earth; refreshing acidity & soft finish

Tommasi Ripasso, Veneto 55.

Opens with ripe fruit tones, inky concentration

and thick aromas of spice and smoke, the wine tastes round and soft on the palate and ends with tight, gripping firmness Super Tuscans

Sanguineti, Nessun Dorma 44.

A blend of Sangiovese, Merlot and Syrah, aromas of underbrush, toasted notes and dark berry. The firm palate offers dried cherry, blackberry and a hint of truffle alongside chewy tannins

'16 Campogiovanni Rosso di Montalcino 50.

Aromas of dark cherry and blackberry with notes of cedar wood; well-structured and smooth with youthful, edgy tannins

'16 Bell'Aja, Bolgheri 55.

Bouquet redolent of wild berry preserves, lifted by smooth notes of spice. On the palate, it is beautifully balanced and delicious, with supple, velvety tannins

'17 Aia Vecchia, "Sor Ugo" Bolgheri Superiore 70.

A fabulous blend of Cab, Merlot & Petit Verdot, round and rich, spicy on the mid-palate, flavors of black currant, licorice & coffee, long-lasting finish

Chianti

Viticcio Chianti Classico, Toscana 48.

Intense aromas of black currant, blackberry, flint, tar & black pepper, vibrant and solidly tannic, lingering aftertaste of dark fruit and mineral.

'18 Castello di Ama, 'Ama' Chianti Classico Riserva, Toscana 60. Black cherry, raspberry, leather, tar and earth flavors, generous texture. Sturdy tannins line the finish, showing purity, balance and length

Reserves

'12 Casanona Di Neri Brunello di Montalcino 100.

Raspberry, cherry, floral, mineral and tobacco are at the center of this linear, vibrant well-structured wine.

'15 Antinori, Pian della Vigne Brunello di Montalcino 130.

Savory cherry, iron, tobacco and underbrush flavors play into the dusty tannins, pushing the fruit to the background.

'12 Maccagatta, "Cole" Barbaresco 90.

Round and supple, with cherry and raspberry fruit, underscored by a broad swath of tannins. Expressive, balanced and long, showing complexity and fine tannins.







A & D, Cabernet, North Coast 40.

Full-bodied, juicy, ripe red and black-cherry flavors, and hints of chocolate

BV, Napa Valley 50.

Blackberry, black cherry and juicy plum characters unfold with complex nuances of violet and mocha into a lingering finish

Faust, Napa Valley 80.

Youthful, thick & tannic, w/leather & oak, sage and cedar, black current and cherry.

Pinot Noir

Joliesse, Pinot Noir, California 40.

Notes of cherry pie, sun ripened strawberry and a hint of cinnamon linger. Delicate and well balanced.

Schug, Carneros 45.

Lightly aromatic and light-bodied, with an emphasis on delicacy, allowing the mix of tar and licorice to rise and gain prominence

Lucienne, "Smith Vineyard", Santa Lucia 70. Robust cherry, spice and earth, balanced and round, lingering finish

Bottles of Red: Around the World

Margarett's Vineyard, Merlot, California 36. Silky, elegant and supple with ripe black cherries, plums and toasty oak.

Llama, Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 40. Intense nose of cherries, blackberries and plums, well rounded and well-structured on the palate, ample fruit flavors and light oak

Marietta, "Roman Estate", Zinfandel, North Coast, California 45.

Nose of black plums, blackberries, licorice & touches of tar, charcoal, & Indian spices. Full-bodied with firm, rustic tannins w/ a long finish

Ontañón Rioja Crianza, Spain 45.

Tempranillo-Garnacha blend with cherry, berry and plum; supple, lightly smoky with juicy acidity

El Enemigo Malbec, Argentina 50. Full bodied with aromas of black fruit, cherr

Full bodied with aromas of black fruit, cherry, spicy blackberry and a lengthy, elegant finish

L'Ecole No. 4 Merlot, Columbia Valley 55. Expressive cherry and dark chocolate notes, persistent with ample tannins on the finish



Tintero Moscato D'Asti Piedmont (1/2 bottle) 18. Deliciously refreshing with its creamy, fizzy texture and weightless nectar

Emilia-Romagna 28.
Bright & tangy, wild berry & cherry fruit, spiced finish

BiancaVigna Prosecco Brut, Veneto 40. Light-bodied and juicy, offering hints of D'Anjou pear, spring blossom & black licorice, with a modest smoke-tinged finish

Laurent-Perrier Brut Champagne, France 75. Classic brut Champagne in every way

Rosé & Whites

Villa Wolf, Pflaz, Germany 36.

Made from Pinot Noir grapes, light, refreshing, with deliciously bright berry & fruit flavors.

Trullo, Riesling, Rheinhessen, Germany 32. Juicy flavors of tropical fruit, melons and green apple. Off-dry finishing with a fresh burst of citrus and minerals.

Broadbent, Vinho Verde, Portugal 35. Light, crisp and fresh-tasting, with good definition to the citrus and green pear flavors

Cembra Sauvignon Blanc, Trentino 36. A snappy, grassy Sauvignon, with tangy acidity and flavors of white peach and tangerine

Pieropan, Soave Classico, Veneto 36.
Bright, fragrant, light-bodied, with ripe apricot, lime blossom, stone and blood orange zest

CP Chardonnay, Paso Robles 40. Rich, complex & refreshing, wonderful lively character with subtle oak in the background.

La Torretta Pinot Grigio, Veneto 40. Aromas of citrus and white flowers. Dry and fresh with green apples and tropical fruit flavors

Leth, Grüner Veltliner, Austria 40. Apple, grapefruit and green peach flavors, fresh, juicy and spicy with a well-structured finish.

Ferrari-Carano Chardonnay, Sonoma 48. Ripe peach and apple flavors, a touch of oak and creaminess; honeysuckle and vanilla finish
